All voices hold a note in the key of Ab for a full measure, then switch to another note at random at each new measure of repeat. Soloist reads from a Book of Mormon, Enos 1:5-8, over the random chords. Once done, conductor can cut off the repeating and move on. This section is also optional, as you can just skip to measure 21 if the director chooses. This section could also be done before the last repeat of the first section if the director chooses previously.

For further explanation:

The melody of "*O, Lord, My God*" is composed for the musical, "**The Rainbow Academy**," also by Peter Morgan. This arrangement employs *aleatoric (chance)* music in the last repeat of the third section and in section marked (C). Both of the mentioned sections could also be thought of as *process music by chance*, as each have a specific direction to spontaneity. The arrangement is inspired by "*holy minimalism*" using repeating hymn-style melody to inspire joy and spiritual transcendence.
